


# The time is ripe for BIM – an initial excerpt from the CONJECT BIM survey 2015

Digitisation in the age of Industry 4.0 has the potential to change the construction industry on a lasting basis. In particular, it is expected that Building Information Modelling (BIM) will make a key contribution to the long-term advancement of our industry. The time seems ripe to join in the “BIM boom” – at least in theory. CONJECT was interested in the practical implementation of the method, and asked about the application of BIM in markets around the world. Initial results show that the UK is leading the way and that, on the whole, the more familiar our respondents were with the trend, the more positively they rated it. When asked about reasons that speak against the use of BIM, those surveyed did not restrict themselves to putting the blame on “others” but were also quite frank in pointing out their own lack of expertise.
